This challenge invites you to use simple materials – paper, crayons, markers, pencils, pens and paint – to depict the world as you imagine it.

ART CHALLENGE #3: Game On!

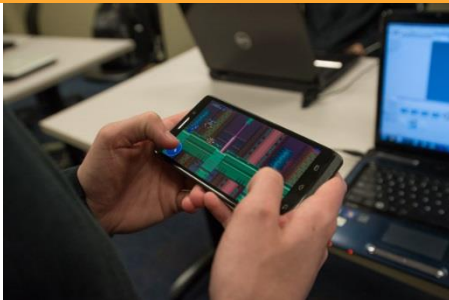
Create your own game in any format -- a classic board game or video game. Send a photo depicting your game & we'll contact you for details.
